

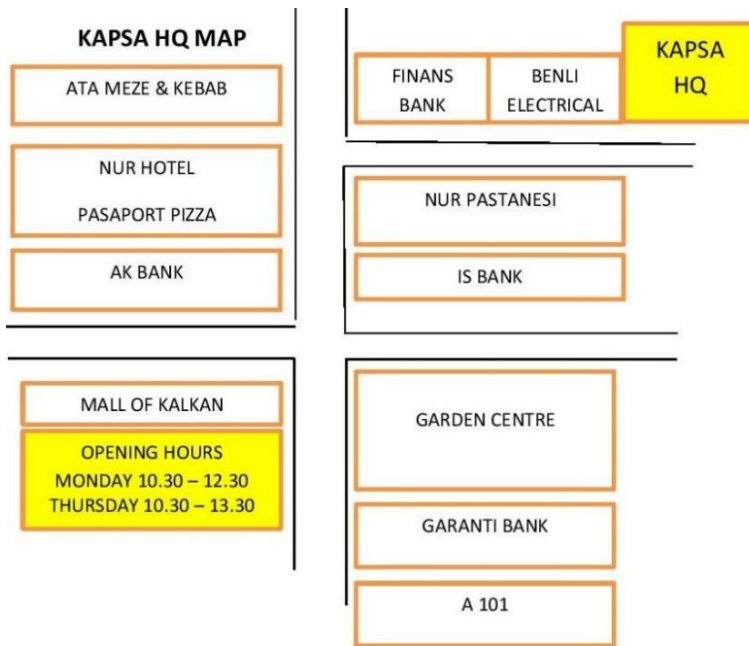
**Is your suitcase full?**
